Drinking over the Festive Season

The UK's Chief Medical Officers have launched their new alcohol drinking guidelines just in time for the Christmas and New Year festivities and the bad news is that they have declared...



There is no such thing as a "safe level" of alcohol consumption

However, as the vast majority of us who enjoy a drink are highly unlikely to suddenly abstain, the recommendation is that we reduce the risks by :

- Limit your daily intake to 2-3 units per day.
- Drink no more than 14 units per week on a regular basis.
- If you drink as much as 14 units per week, spread your drinking evenly over 3 or more days.
- Try to have 2-3 alcohol free days per week.
- If you are intending to drink alcohol try to drink water regularly throughout the day and again before you go to sleep.

So, here's wishing you a Merry, but not too Merry, Xmas and a Happy New Year.



Tired of waiting on hold?

Did you know that you can order your repeat medications using your computer, tablet or smartphone?

With Online Services you can order your repeat medications 24 hours a day without the need to phone the practice or bring in your prescription counterfoil (side-slip). You can also check the date and time of any appointments you have with us and cancel them if you can no longer attend, saving valuable NHS resources. By using Online Services, not only will you be saving yourself time but you will be helping us keep our phone lines free for patients who need to speak to a doctor.

If you would like to use this service, or have a friend, relative or carer do this on your behalf, please bring some form of identification to the practice and ask one of our receptionists for an Online Services account.

ONLINE SECURITY

One of our members is an IT consultant and has this message for any patients who elect to use our online services:



If you use your computer to order prescriptions or to access your medical records, you need to protect your data

(and the same applies if you do things such as online banking)

You should consider using a firewall and you need good anti-virus software. It is not expensive – reasonable anti-virus software is available for around £30 to £40 for a one-year subscription – about the same cost as buying one cappuccino per month. Even the most expensive options will still cost you less than £2 per week.

Think what might happen if you do not take these simple steps – your identity stolen, your bank account emptied...don't let it happen to you.

Anti-virus Software can easily be purchased online. If you are in any doubt about what to do, ask wherever you bought your PC. They may even have a service to provide the software and to set it up for you.
